D. BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE	
Please briefly present the partner organisation.	<p>Founded in 1974, Sivas Cumhuriyet University stands as one of the distinguished public institutions of higher education in the Republic of Türkiye. Situated in the historically rich and culturally vibrant city of Sivas, the University is committed to upholding academic excellence, advancing scientific research, and fostering societal development.</p> <p>Sivas Cumhuriyet University continues its educational and research activities through 18 faculties, 4 graduate school, 1 state conservatory, and 4 schools, 14 vocational schools, serving over 50,000 students.</p>



	<p>The university employs 2,345 academic staff and 3,542 administrative staff and has graduated more than 180,000 students since its establishment. With its experienced academic structure, active international cooperation, and strong commitment to regional and national development, Sivas Cumhuriyet University continues to expand its educational, research, and internationalisation activities in line with its guiding principle, “from tradition to the future.”</p>
<p>What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?</p>	<p>Sivas Cumhuriyet University carried out its first Erasmus mobility in 2006. Between 2014 and 2023, the university implemented a total of 2,059 mobilities, including 1,398 students and 661 staff members.</p> <p>The university first participated in the KA171 International Credit Mobility programme in 2016. According to the 2019 KA171 project results, projects with 25 partner countries were accepted, and with a total grant of €1,068,000, Sivas Cumhuriyet University became one of the universities in Türkiye receiving the highest amount of KA171 funding. As of 2023, the university has continued to take part in KA171 projects on an annual basis.</p> <p>Sivas Cumhuriyet University began its consortium activities in 2019 as a partner in the project titled “Seven Doors,” coordinated by Uşak University, which included seven universities and seven chambers of commerce and industry. The university also participated in the 2020 Seven Doors consortium project, carrying out student traineeship mobility and staff training mobility activities.</p> <p>Building on this initial consortium experience, the university prepared and coordinated its first consortium project in 2021, which was awarded a grant of €40,000. Continuing to strengthen its capacity in consortium projects, Sivas Cumhuriyet University participated as a consortium partner in projects coordinated by Abdullah Gül University and Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University in 2022. These projects continued in 2023, and applications for 2024 consortium projects were also submitted.</p>

	<p>The Seven Doors consortium projects (2019–2020) primarily aimed to support mobility in the field of engineering, and mobilities were successfully implemented within this framework.</p> <p>In 2024, Sivas Cumhuriyet University further strengthened its experience in international and inter-institutional project development by coordinating in a consortium project prepared in cooperation with Hitit University, Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University, Kırşehir Ahi Evran University, and Amasya University. The project, focusing on Crimean–Congo Hemorrhagic Fever (CCHF), was awarded a total grant of €47,950, contributing to research, cooperation, and capacity-building activities in this field.</p> <p>Through its growing experience in Erasmus+, international credit mobility, and consortium projects, Sivas Cumhuriyet University continues to expand its partnerships, strengthen institutional capacity, and contribute to regional and international academic cooperation. The university remains committed to enhancing the quality and impact of mobility, research, and collaborative projects in line with its internationalisation strategy.</p>
<p>What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons involved in this application?</p>	<p>The key staff involved in this application consist of experienced members of the International Relations Office and Erasmus+ Coordination Office of Sivas Cumhuriyet University, who have extensive experience in Erasmus+ project management, mobility coordination, and international cooperation.</p> <p>Prof. Dr. Suleyman Degirmen – Vice Rector, Head of the International Relations Office and Erasmus+ Institutional Coordinator Provides overall strategic leadership, supervises international cooperation activities, and oversees the planning and implementation of Erasmus+ projects and institutional partnerships.</p> <p>Lect. Emre Seven – Erasmus+ Institutional Vice Coordinator Responsible for the coordination of KA171 projects, incoming KA171 mobilities, staff week organisation, and inclusion and diversity activities,</p>

as well as coordination of office staff and Eurodesk activities.

Lect. Murat Ercan – Erasmus+ Institutional Vice Coordinator
